



## **Dear WFMA Students,**

We are excited to return to classes, to teach you, and to support your work as artists! We know you have questions about how things will work now that you'll be engaging in this work online and not in person. We have some, but not all, of the answers, and inevitably we will have to adjust and flex, week by week, in order to land in a place that works for everyone. We are lucky, because we know that so much of what we do together will transition well to these new modes of learning, and that no matter where you are, you will have stories to tell. We've always believed that the creative process benefits from constraint, and we feel confident that each of you will continue to bring your unique voice, vision, and unstoppable creativity to the work ahead.

## **Schedule**

WFMA will continue to run all of its Spring Semester classes on the same days of the week as before break. Teachers will hold live, interactive class sessions over Zoom between 2:30pm-4pm EST. This time will be used by teachers for large and small group work, discussions, interactive assignments and prompts, Q & A's that benefit the whole group, and logistics and planning. You may not be "in class" or online every day for the whole 90 minutes, but you should prepare to show up at 2:30pm and protect that time, as best you can.

Because we have students that will be in different time zones and/or have other scheduling difficulties, we know classes might not have a critical mass of students on some or all days. If your schedule prohibits you from joining the interactive Zoom sessions, the teachers will support you through other touchpoints: smaller group sessions with other students in your time



zone and one-on-one meetings with us. Additionally, all interactive class sessions over Zoom will be recorded and made available to those who were not able to attend.

Between 10am-11am and 4pm-7pm, we have allocated time similar to Open Studio, to be used for individual or smaller group work, as well as one-on-one sessions with faculty. Some classes may decide that these periods will work better for the live, interactive work, and will want to shift. As mentioned before, it may take us a week or two to figure out what will work best. As teachers, we are thinking very hard about what kinds of work are best suited for live class sessions and what kinds of work will be best for you to do or schedule with others on your own.

In addition to keeping up with the class live or through the recordings, the expectation is that you will have at least one individual check-in, via email or video conference, with each of your teachers every week.

## **Department Meeting**

Department Meeting will take place on Mondays at 10am EST. We hope this will be an opportunity for all of us to gather in the same virtual space at the same time.

Classes will be graded pass/fail based on student engagement, effort, and completion of tasks and assignments.

### Collaboration

Collaboration is central to the mission of our department. Even though we will be working together remotely, we remain committed to incorporating group work and group projects into our classes. While this will look and feel very different from what it would in person, we will find structures and practices that will continue to enable collaborative processes and creative exchange between you and your WFMA classmates.

This spring, we will continue to guide and support you in the preparation of individual work for presentation as we would for Black on White or Senior Shows.
